Statutory Measures No. 2, No. 3, and No. 4 were placed on the ballot by initiative petition. These measures are being submitted to the voters of North Dakota for their approval or rejection. Vote by darkening the oval (●) opposite either the word "YES" or "NO" following the summary of each question.</p>	<p><b>Constitutional Measure No. 1 (House Concurrent Resolution No. 3045, 2007 Session Laws, Ch. 584)</b></p> <p>This constitutional measure would add a new section to Article X of the North Dakota Constitution.</p> <p>This measure would establish a permanent oil tax trust fund from oil and gas tax revenue exceeding one hundred million dollars per biennium, adjusted for inflation; interest earnings on the trust fund would be transferred to the general fund each year; and no more than twenty percent of the principal of the trust fund could be spent each biennium, if approved by three-fourths of the members of both houses of the legislature.</p> <p><input type="radio"/> <b>YES</b> - Means you approve the measure as summarized above.</p> <p><input type="radio"/> <b>NO</b> - Means you reject the measure as summarized above.</p>
